The competition is comprised of 12 men's teams and 12 women's teams. Each gender will be divided into two pools of 6 teams. At the conclusion of the round robin, the top team in each pool will play the second place team in the opposite pool in the semi final. The two winners will meet in the championship final and the losers will be recognized as bronze medal winners. Ties for final playoff positions will be broken by tie breaker games. The pools are identified as: Women (A & B) and Men (C & D).
